



K-12 EXCHANGE OF GOODS LOCKERS

HOW IT WORKS:

BROKEN DEVICE EXCHANGE

We've made it easier than ever to get a broken device fixed.

After notifying IT, register your broken device for a drop-off at the touchscreen, IT staff is immediately notified and is able to retrieve the device from the locker bank as well as assign you a loaner device if needed to be picked up. IT will fix it, deposit it back into the locker bank, and then you'll be notified when it's ready for pick-up. It's that simple!





DEVICE CHECK-OUT/CHECK-IN

We believe that our exchange of goods lockers can streamline the check-in/check-out of devices process as well, making it easy for you to get your hands on the equipment you need when you need it.

With lockers allocated to specific equipment such as, laptops, tablets, keyboards, monitors, and more it makes for a streamlined checkout for students or staff.

1. Notify IT staff about your needs
2. IT staff then assigns the locker with the laptop to them temporarily (with a 4-digit PIN or QR code)
3. When it's convenient, you'll be able to pick up the device at the assigned locker.
4. When returning the device, repeat the process: present your 4-digit PIN or show your QR code to the reader and return your device for the next person to borrow.

EXCHANGE OF GOODS LOCKERS FLEXIBILITY

Once the bank of lockers is installed in your school, the flexibility and creativity of use cases begins. How about ensuring that confidential documents get into the right hands? Or, depending on where the lockers are located, a parent can drop off lunch that was forgotten on the kitchen counter. As you can see, these lockers can be used for needs stretching far beyond just IT equipment exchange.

LOCKER CONFIGURATION

When it comes to the exchange of goods, the size can range from a computer mouse to a laptop. Don't overcompensate and purchase all large locker openings—that's just a waste of space. Design your lockers to have various sized openings all within one locker bank, plus easily add locker columns if the lockers are constantly at full capacity.

Locker design doesn't stop at locker door openings. Add a personalized touch by incorporating school colors or even your school mascot with a custom locker graphic overlay. With school pride expressed throughout your hallways, don't let your bank of lockers be an exception.
