Bedlift Hospital Bed Storage

Hospital beds need a proper home when they are not in use. And by proper home, we aren't referring to a secluded hallway down in the basement, or shoved to one side of a maintenance room. No, the proper home is the **Bedlift** – a vertical storage system for hospital beds. With the **Bedlift**, hospitals can now increase storage capacity and protection of their out-of-service hospital beds while satisfying *The Joint Commission* standards and avoiding potential fines.

The **Bedlift** offers an automated lift that accommodates most beds in the market. Three models allow the user to choose the height, thus the number of beds they can store in a column. Users can store 3, 4, or 5 beds in a footprint slightly larger than a single bed, recovering up to 70% of floor space.

- » The beds are secure and protected, reducing the risk of damage.
- » The beds can be stored in a centralized area, cutting down on misplaced inventory.
