STORING M4-MOUNTED M320s

Spacesaver's UWR® accommodates larger M320 grenade launchers





The U.S Armed Forces are in the process of switching from the M203 grenade launcher to the M320, which can be fired as a standalone weapon but which is also commonly affixed to an M4. Featuring improved optics and side-loading capabilities, the M320 is more powerful and accurate than its predecessors, but it's also significantly bulkier. It is approximately 7 inches wide, and its larger size has created a storage challenge for the Marine Corps. Personnel wanted to continue using their Spacesaver UWR® Storage Systems, but they were finding that the typical UWR configuration for M4s could not accommodate the new grenade launchers.

Spacesaver has confirmed that M4s with the M320 attached can be stored five across in a 45" UniversalTM Weapons Rack. An additional five M4s can be stored, with optics affixed, across the bottom of the rack. The photos above show how it works: Spacesaver's inverted weapons bracket securely stores five M4s with M320s across the top, and five more M4s are stored barrel up, staggered between the inverted weapons.

As with all Spacesaver products, the UWR is designed and manufactured in the USA.
