Biological & Tissue Samples

Some samples need to stay contained, others just need to stay visible and easy to grab. Stainless steel cabinets stand up to formaldehyde, static shelving keeps specimens organized, and evidence lockers step in for refrigeration or restricted access.



Instruments & Equipment

Everyday exam tools stay visible and within reach, while forensic equipment needs to be protected and out of the way. Static or mobile shelving handles the everyday stuff, with stainless steel cabinets covering anything that needs to stay contained between cases.



Supplies

Supply rooms live or die by how easy they are to navigate. High-density mobile shelving handles bulk cartons, static shelving keeps everyday essentials visible and easy to restock, and cabinets give the rest a cleaner, contained home.



PPE Storage

Protective gear only works if your team can get to it fast. Personal storage lockers give assigned gear a dedicated spot, cabinets keep shared supplies out of sight, and static shelving keeps boxed PPE within quick reach.
