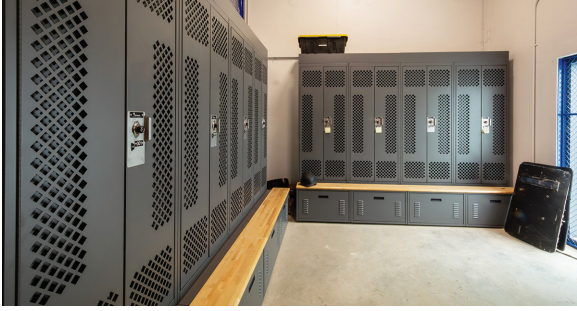

Storage That Puts the Correct in Corrections

Most correctional facilities are overcrowded and tight on space, managing more STUFF than the room was built for: inmate property, records, weapons, and medical supplies, all competing for the same square footage. Patterson Pope builds storage systems that make room for all of it, without asking the facility for more space.



Records & Inmate Property Storage

Case files and inmate property don't have much in common, except that both pile up fast and need to stay easy to locate. Rotary file cabinets keep records quick to pull, 4-post shelving gives bulk property a stable home, and hanging bags keep folded items from turning into a wrinkled mess.



Weapons & Armory Storage

Officers checking in sidearms and an armory holding everything from rifles to ammo share the same basic need: a secure, dedicated spot for every weapon. Wall mounted gun lockers give handguns a fast, secure home, universal weapons racks keep long guns upright and organized, and high-density mobile shelving stores ammo without eating up the room.



Locker Room Storage

A locker room is more than storage; it's part of how officers start and end a shift. Personal storage lockers give every officer a secure, dedicated spot for gear and personal items, while steel lockers hold up to daily wear without looking worse for it.



Infirmery Storage

Quality care starts with organization, so medications, tests, and equipment all need to be exactly where staff expect them. Modular casework builds structure around the room's actual workflow, FrameWRX bin shelving keeps small supplies visible and sorted, and cabinets give sensitive items a locked, dedicated home.
